

COVID-19 Volunteer Recommendations

Thank you for caring for our refugee and immigrant neighbors. Due to COVID-19 social distancing measures, we recognize that volunteering may continue to look different. The safety of our clients, volunteers, and staff remains a high priority.

In accordance with state guidelines, Arrive Ministries recommends the following:

- Limit the number of people meeting
- Limit your time together
- Call before you visit to ensure everyone is healthy
- Wear a mask
- Spend time outside! <https://arriveministries.org/winter-activities-2/>
- Programs/classes meeting at a site can operate at 25% capacity

We have observed that in-person meetings are oftentimes more meaningful than virtual meetings. However, please remember that the people we serve may be members of vulnerable populations. Additionally, many are from cultures that highly value hospitality, and for that reason, they may feel uncomfortable turning you away from their home. With that in mind, please do what is best for the family you are working with and be sure to ask them frequently how and if they want to meet.
