In our world today, 65 million people have been forcibly displaced from their homes, and 34,000 additional people are displaced every single day. The need to welcome refugees to the United States has never been greater.

Now is the time to take a stand.

THE GOAL

The goal of Stand With Refugees is to raise our voices in support of refugees coming to the United States. We want to rally advocates around the United States to make 100,000 calls to Congress the week before (June 12th-16th) World Refugee Day on June 20th! On World Refugee Day, we will announce how many calls were made to demonstrate broad support for welcoming refugees.

MESSAGE

We are asking callers to communicate the following message when calling Congress: "In honor of World Refugee Day, I am calling in support of welcoming refugees to the United States. I urge Congress to welcome more refugees to the U.S. next year and provide adequate funding levels to assist refugees worldwide."

HOW IT WORKS

UNTIL JUNE 12TH

Text "STAND" to 313131 and get a reminder on June 12th to call. During this time, spread the word and rally people to join the movement!

JUNE 12TH - 16TH

Call your Member of Congress! 1-844-4STAND5 will connect people directly to their Members of Congress. People can also go to StandWithRefugees.us to call Congress through the website.

JUNE 20TH

On World Refugee Day, we will celebrate the resilience of refugees and lift up our collective voice to support refugees around the world and in the U.S.
