

# What to Do if you Move

## 1. Complete the AR-11 form for United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS)

A form needs completed for each member of the family.

## 2. Update your address with the World Relief Travel Loan Department: (800) 901-1951

## 3. Update your address with your County Case Worker

- [Printable Form](#)

Only the “Change in Address” section needs completed. This form can be mailed or emailed to the county caseworker, or refugees can call their caseworker to report this change.

## 4. Update your Mailing Address with the Post Office

- You may call (800) 275-8777, [update online](#), or visit a local post office

## 5. Call the Utility Companies

## 6. Update your address with the Children’s School(s)
